

## CHECKLIST FOR PERSONS FILING DOCUMENTS – DIRECT PRIVATE PARTY ACTIONS/COMPLAINTS

THIS DOCUMENT IS NOT A SUBSTITUTE FOR INDIVIDUAL PROFESSIONAL ADVICE. THE ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION HAS PREPARED THIS DOCUMENT MERELY AS A GUIDE. IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOU SEEK LEGAL ADVICE FOR YOUR PARTICULAR CASE.

The procedure for filing Direct Private Party Actions/Complaints is set out in the Environmental Management Act, 2000 and the Environmental Commission Rules of Practice and Procedure, 2001. You should therefore ensure compliance with these in preparing and filing your documents. Failure to do so may result in your documents being struck out and your application being dismissed.

Before filing your Notice of Direct Private Party Action/Complaint you should verify the following:

- o that the title of the Notice of Direct Private Party Action/Complaint has been included;
- o that a full description of the nature of the Direct Private Party Action/Complaint has been included;
- o that any remedy being sought has been included;
- o that the names and addresses of all persons intended to be served with the Notice of Direct Private Party Action/Complaint have been included;
- o that the Notice of Direct Private Party Action/Complaint is accompanied by the Written Notice of Claimed Violation sent to the EMA under section 69(1)(a);
- o that the Notice of Direct Private Party Action/Complaint includes proof of the Written Notice of Claimed Violation having actually been sent to the Managing Director of the EMA as required by section 69(1)(a) of the Act;
- o that the Notice of Direct Private Party Action/Complaint states whether the proceedings are filed out of time and if so, is endorsed with a reason for late filing. If your Direct Private Party Action/Complaint is out of time you should first file an Application for an Extension of Time to File your Notice of Direct Private Party Action/Complaint;
- o that the Respondent is correctly identified;
- o that the Notice of Direct Private Party Action/Complaint is dated and signed;
- o that the Applicant's/Complainant's address for service is clearly stated;
- o that you have brought the original and at least seven (7) copies of the Notice of Application (i.e. the original and four (4) copies to be retained by the Registry; one (1) for <u>each</u> person intended to be served with the Notice <u>including</u> every Respondent and the Managing Director of the Environmental Management Authority; and one (1) for yourself);
- o that you have securely bound all exhibits and accompanying documents to the Notice of Application/Complaint.



<u>You are responsible</u> for ensuring that the date and time of the hearing are inserted in the Notice of Direct Private Party Action/Complaint. At the time of filing you will be given this date and time by the Registry Clerk. You must fill in this information on the original and all copies before the Notice of Direct Private Party Action/Complaint is filed.

Before leaving the Registry verify that all of your copies have been stamped as "Filed" and "Sealed" with the Seal of the Environmental Commission.

After you have served the Notice of Direct Private Party Action/Complaint you may wish to file an Affidavit of Service. This formally notifies the Environmental Commission that the other party has been served with the Notice of Private Party Action/Complaint and may expedite the hearing of the matter by allowing the Commission to set the earliest practical date for the Preliminary hearing of the matter. An example of an Affidavit of Service is attached hereto.
